Limit: TWO garments or ONE ensemble.

Make two copies of each form (one garment per form – must be easily readable):

2) Attach the completed form to the garment. Turn in garment with form at Show Registration before registration closes on Thursday.

How to keep your garment from being rejected: Garments without forms or with unreadable forms will be rejected. Garment description must be complete. Garments without sewn in labels will be rejected (each garment must have a sewn in label identifying who to return it to). Forms and garments need to be turned in on time.
